Dr. Conway joined the University of Wisconsin-Madison School of Medicine and Public Health Department of Pediatrics in 2005, in the Division of Pediatric Infectious Disease, as an Associate Professor (CHS). He was previously on the faculty at the Indiana University School of Medicine at the Riley Hospital for Children where he served as Pediatric Residency Associate Program Director, and founded the International Adoption Clinic there. He attended Cornell University for his undergraduate and medical education, completed a Pediatric Residency at Northwestern University-Children's Memorial Hospital in Chicago, and a Pediatric Infectious Diseases Fellowship at the University of Colorado Children's Hospital in Denver.

He is a member of the Wisconsin State Dept. of Health Committee on Immunization Practice, Chair of the UW Immunization Task Force, on the Board of Directors for the Dane County Immunization Coalition, and Chair of the Wisconsin AAP Committee on Immunizations and Infectious Disease. He is Board Certified in Pediatrics and Pediatric Infectious Diseases, and is a Fellow in the American Academy of Pediatrics, as well as a member of the Pediatric Infectious Disease Society and Infectious Disease Society of America. He was recently named to the international Syphilis Education Council.

Among his many academic interests are issues related to global health for children, especially related to vaccine-preventable disease. He is a member of the Steering Committee for the newly created Center for Global Health at the University of Wisconsin, and currently involved in a long-term project with the Merck Foundation working toward improving immunization coverage rates in east Africa.
