Meeting was called to order by Jeneile Luebke Cleary

Introductions

Presentation by Jerry Gabor – Wisconsin Immunization Program – Student immunization Law (Administrative Rule HFS 144) – see handout enclosed.

Mr. Gabor –presentation focused around the Student Immunization Law changes.

Chapter I – 144

- New requirements in Administrative rule Tdap – 6th 9th and 12th grades starting this fall - 08
- Wisconsin ranks 5th in the nation for pertussis- because we have a good reporting systems.
- Second dose of varicella fro students entering kindergarten, 6th and 12th grade starting in the fall 08

Op-out

- Varicella – if child had disease.
- If TD received in last five years would be in compliance and won't need a Tdap
- Waivers are still an option. 3% waivers in WI (all)
- Frequently asked question document will be used for vareceilla (mild/moderate/severe).

Pneumococcal (PCV)

- Required for licensed daycares beginning Sept 1, 2008
- 5 months – 15 months – 2doses
- 16 months – 23 months – 3 doses
- 2 years – 4 years – 3 doses
- This doesn't necessary reflect ACIP

New recommendations

- Registry is built around ACIP schedule child/adult
- Information went out via mail to pediatricians and family practice providers.
- Posted on web and information sent to tribal entities.

Measles Update – See website

- 4 confirmed cases, currently investigating.
- Sending specimens to Wis State lab
- 1 adult and 3 children
- Some children properly immunized, however, they are looking into this.
- As long as this continues may get community spread
- Immunizations for MMR may increase
- If exposure of those under 12months, they can get Ig and MMR but this is NOT endorsed. Only recommended if there is a Sate outbreak.

Board of Directors Report- Sandy Jacobson

- Dean rep will be Deb Paulus
- New representative from GHC – Gwen Long (Safety Infection and Control)- she is new to this position and getting settled in, but expresses interest in joining the coalition.
