New shingles vaccine update—Alan Barker, GSK

Shingrix (Zoster Vaccine Recombinant, Adjuvanted)

- Not live vaccine
- Not frozen
- Given IM
- 2 doses

ACIP voted a few weeks ago and was approved

Waiting for MMWR. Needs to be published before insurance companies will cover it.

Shingrix vaccine was developed to overcome the declining immunity with age. Shingles is more prevalent and more severe with increasing age and the current vaccine Zostavax wanes with age. Efficacy studies showed 91% effective and it doesn't decline with age.

Vaccine will probably be available Feb/March 2018

- Marshall Schools 7/2017 Held on site during school registration. Concentrated on adolescent platform
- MMSD Community Schools. Flu on site at Leopold and Mendota Elementary Schools
HyVee Pharmacy was able to do patients over 6 years and bill insurance. PH did the 6 and under and the uninsured.
- Marshall Headstart. Flu on site for students and families. Student nurses and PHMDC nurses will immunize
- Offsite flu clinics. PHMDC supplies the vaccine and supplies. Vaccines given by student nurses and pharmacists
 - Operation Fresh Start
 - Foot Care Clinic for Homeless

- Medic Clinics
- Homeless shelters
