If You Ride the Bus to School...

- Morning drop off is at the front entrance of the Middle School.
- Afternoon pick up is at the **Intermediate Center**. Walk to the IC using sidewalks and crosswalks. **Buses leave the IC at 3:35 pm.**
- Follow all bus rules for your continued ability to ride.



If You Walk to School...



- **Always** use the crosswalks and the crossing guard at the corner of S. 8th Street and Garfield. After school, crossing guards are posted at the crosswalk on Garfield Street between the High School and Middle School and behind the Middle School on Lincoln Street.
- **Do NOT cross in the middle of the street.**

YOUR SAFETY IS IMPORTANT TO US!

We need the cooperation of ALL parents and students to make this Traffic Safety Plan work.

If You are Driven to School...

- Use the front entrance on Garfield Street.
- For drop off and pick up, **please stay in the far right lane.** *In the morning, please give way to buses dropping off students.*
- If you need to come into the school office, please use the left lane upon entering and park in the Staff/Visitor Lot. **Never drop students off in the left lane** as this creates dangerous crossing through moving cars.
- The Staff/Visitor Lot is **NOT** a drop off/pick up or turn around area.
- Exit the Middle School drop off and pick up lane by exiting to the right onto Lincoln Street.
- Traffic flow at the Middle School is one way, **Please observe all traffic patterns and posted signs.**

Please observe all street signs and all traffic, parking and pedestrian laws. The Mount Horeb Police will ticket anyone who violates these laws while dropping off or picking up a child(ren).

Drivers must yield the right of way to pedestrians crossing the street at a marked crosswalk.

If You Bike or Skateboard to School...



- **Always** wear your helmet while biking and skateboarding.
- Park and lock your bike in the designated bicycle rack only.
- Do not ride on school grounds or sidewalks and be cautious of cars and pedestrians.
