

Van Hise Elementary School Traffic Safety Brochure

The Van Hise School has adopted the following plan for student drop off/pick up. Following input from parents, school, and city staff, the plan was first adopted in the spring of 2002.

If you drive your child to/from school, please read the guidelines and look at the map to determine a plan for getting your child to school.

The plan applies to the following times:

Monday	7:30 - 8:00 a.m. 1:00 - 1:30 p.m.
Tuesday- Friday	7:30 - 8:00 a.m. 2:30 - 3:00 p.m.

Guidelines for Student Drop Off/Pick Up

Drop off on Segoe Rd. on the school side of the street. The parking lot off of Segoe Rd. is used for teachers and staff only. **Please do not drop your child off in this parking lot.**

Drop off on Waukesha in designated areas. Signs are posted and enforced by the police. Please drop your child off on the school side of the street. This will prevent unwanted delays as well as accidents.

PLEASE OBSERVE ALL STREET SIGNS AND TRAFFIC, PARKING AND PEDESTRIAN LAWS

“No Stopping Standing or Parking”

Signs used to convey where it is illegal to stop or leave standing any vehicle. The only vehicles allowed are buses; therefore these signs are used in areas intended for school bus use only. **In these areas, you may not drop a child off, pick a child up, wait in your car, or park your car.**

“No Parking” and “No Parking on School Days”

Signs used to indicate areas where motorists may stop and discharge passengers, but **may not** leave the vehicle unattended. These signs are used in areas intended for motorists to use to drop off or pick up passengers. **In these areas, you may drop a child off and pick a child up. However, you must remain with your car.**

- It is illegal to doublepark to drop off or pick up your child, even if you remain in the car. This disrupts traffic and is not safe.
- It is illegal to park within 4 feet of a driveway, 20 feet of a crosswalk, and 30 feet of a stop sign. It blocks the view of oncoming traffic and puts your child at risk of getting hit.
- Motorists must yield the right-of-way to pedestrians crossing a street at a marked or unmarked crosswalk where there is no traffic signal.
- It is safest to drop off/pick up your child on the school side of the street observing all traffic, parking and pedestrian laws.
