

EXAMPLES OF TRAFFIC SAFETY CONCERNS OBSERVED AT SCHOOLS

These are issues most often seen, need to be addressed and included in education plan.

1. Unlawful Parking (sign violations):

- No Parking (leaving vehicle unattended)
- No Stopping, Standing or Parking
- Handicapped Parking,

2. Unsafe Loading/Unloading:

- Allowing child to exit streetwise
- At T-intersection
- In teacher's parking lot
- Blocking driveway or fire lane
- Buses dropping off at crosswalk or allowing too large of a gap between buses

3. Traffic Concerns:

- Too fast for conditions – parents, neighborhood residents, delivery trucks, buses
- Not stopping at stop sign or red light
- Not stopping for adult crossing guard

4. Unsafe Pedestrian Behaviors:

- Allowing child to cross mid-block, instead of walking up to the crosswalk where Adult Crossing Guard or Student Safety Patrol is located
- Parent walking child mid-block, instead of crossing at crosswalk – modeling bad behavior
