Developing a Principle from a Value

Value example: Focus on **equity**

A few Principle examples:

- Workgroup members include people who are **BIPOC** and staff from **BIPOC-serving organizations**
- We look at outcome **data** by race/ethnicity, gender, and geographic area where feasible
- We harness the **voices of people with lived experience** through listening sessions and other ways
- We **USE** what we hear from people to inform our planning

Developing a Principle from a Value: Example – Focus on Equity

Principle	Data Sources/Methods
Workgroup members include people who are BIPOC and staff from BIPOC-serving organizations	Reviewing workgroup member lists on a regular basis
We look at outcome data by race/ethnicity, gender, and geographic area where feasible	Documenting whether we are breaking down intervention data or community violence measures from our action plans into these demographic groups
We harness the voices of people with lived experience through listening sessions and other ways and we use it to inform our planning.	Tracking document /log of the ways workgroups are incorporating these voices (surveys, focus groups, listening sessions, etc.), populations reached , and how the data are used to inform planning

Roadmap Guiding Principles



- Approach violence prevention with consideration for and incorporation of **Health, Racial, Gender, and Economic Equity**
- Incorporate **voices** of those with **lived violence experiences**
- Address shared **risk** and **protective factors** that cross multiple forms of violence
- Support efforts that create **immediate impact** and **long-term change**
