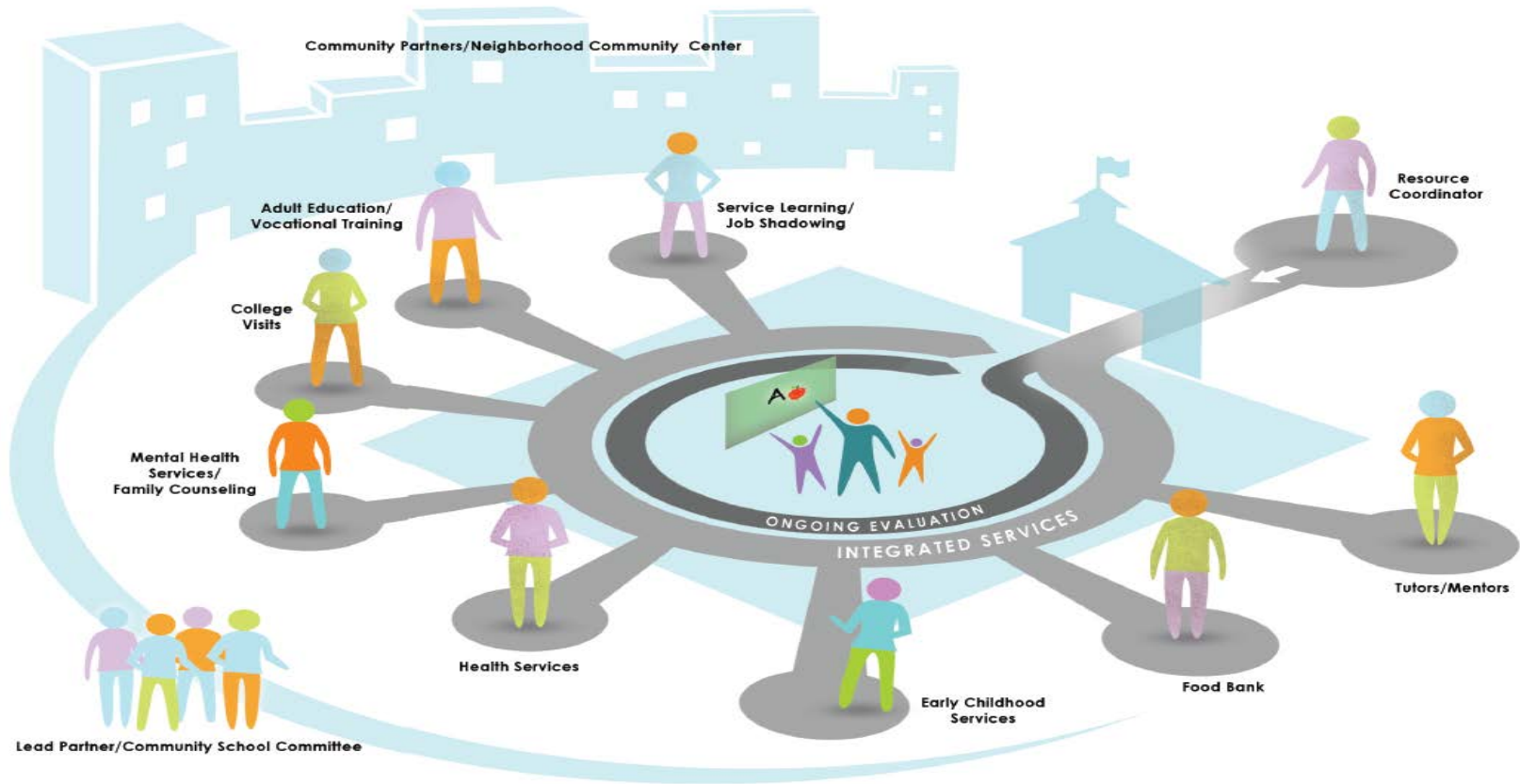

Flu Clinic Process

Consents: on-site completion

WIR: review immunization history

Insurance review: Algorithm determines who vaccinates

Waiting Area: Numbers provided

Vaccine Stations: separate room from waiting area

Receive Culver's coupon for a free scoop of ice cream

Challenges

Consents

Preference to go to own health care provider

No insurance card(s) on hand upon arrival to clinic

Staffing

Overcoming the Challenges

- Consents: On-site completion this past year vs. advanced consent
- Including the Flu Clinic in the advertising of the Community School event.
 - Noting vaccine available at no cost to all participants
 - Note to bring insurance cards if they are insured.
- Staffing
 - New public health staff interested in participating
 - UW SoN opening the option up to more 1st year nursing students
 - MMSD School Nurses being notified and invited earlier this year



Priorities:

1. Expand Schools: Adding Hawthorne this fall
2. Expand available vaccines to children who are non-compliant with Student Immunization Law
3. 2019 Collect Data by Required Vaccine
4. HyVee checking on ability to obtain VFC
5. Pharmacy Law changes allowing pharmacist to vaccinate under age 6

No Changes to the Law for 2019-20 School Year

Recent Public Hearing: If adopted will begin 2020-2021 School Year

- Move Tdap to 7th Grade
- Add Meningococcal for entrance to 7th grade
- Second dose of Meningococcal vaccine for 12th grade entrance
- HCP documentation of Varicella history of disease

Immunization Warning Letter

- First Mailing: September 25th
- Second Mailing: October 9th
- Exclusion Begins: October 19th through October 28th
 - Student may return to school as soon as proof of immunization is available.

Missed Opportunities: Discuss vaccines with families. Go in with intention that families will vaccinate. Use opportunity to obtain all vaccines in one visit.
